Public Transportation

Inner City Transportation - Berliner Verkehrsbetriebe (BVG)

Berlin has a very developed public transportation system, provided by the Berliner Verkehrsbetriebe (BVG). It consists of subways (U-Bahn), city railways (S-Bahn), buses and trams, which connect remote districts of the city, airports and intercity railways.

With the student ID, participants can benefit from a discounted monthly ticket, which is valid on all public transportation. You can find all the information regarding connections, timetables, journey planner, ticket prices, etc. on the following website:
